ENGINE MOUNTING BOLTS

So as to facilitate the service removal and refitting of the engine oil pan, two of the rear engine mounting bolts are to be fitted on production with the bolthead facing uppermost.

To accommodate the production assembly process the third bolt will be fitted head downwards. However, should it be necessary to remove the oil pan, this third bolt may also be fitted with the head facing uppermost during reassembly.
